**Testing of E, D, D+ Efficiency Tests** – PC Members must wear beige or cream jodhpurs, white shirt, Pony Club tie, Pony Club hoodie, gloves, black, navy or brown silk, jodhpur boots and chaps. Long hair must be plaited or in a hair net. No jewellery.

**Testing of C, C+ Efficiency Tests** – PC Members must wear beige or cream jodhpurs, white shirt, Pony Club tie, jacket, gloves, black, navy or brown silk, jodhpur boots and chaps. Long hair must be plaited or in a hair net. No jewellery.
