Pony Club Rallies

We will continue to work towards the E, D, D+, C, C+ and B Efficiency Tests and Achievement/Mini Achievement Badges. If you are interested the syllabus for the Tests and/or Achievement Badges can be viewed and downloaded from the Pony Club website - www.pcuk.org/index.php/tests_and_achievements. If any member would like to complete any "homework" for their Tests or Badges we would recommend they read and learn the relevant sections from The Manual of Horsemanship (14th Edition) which can be purchased from the Pony Club. Please don't worry if you'd prefer not to as it will be fully covered in our Pony Club Rallies!

Cross Country – For all XC lessons and training elbows and collarbones must be covered. Please wear a long sleeved top. A body protector **must** be worn as well as gloves. Riding hats must have a soft peak. All participants must have completed our XC Disclaimer. These are available from the office. Pony Club members wishing to take part in cross country training or competitions must have body protectors meeting the Pony Club's standard – BETA 2009 (Purple Label).

Body Protectors

We no longer supply body protectors for clients to borrow. Please supply your own body protector. Body protectors must be worn for **all** jumping lessons and events.

Dress Codes

Pony Club Rallies - PC Members must wear plain, dark coloured jodhpurs (navy, black or brown) or beige or cream jodhpurs, PC polo shirt and hoodie, black, navy or brown silk, gloves, jodhpur boots and chaps. No jewellery. Long hair must be plaited or in a hair net. **Testing of Pony Club Mini Achievement and Achievement Badges** – PC Members must wear beige or cream jodhpurs, PC polo shirt and hoodie, black, navy or brown silk, gloves, jodhpur boots and chaps. No jewellery. Long hair must be plaited or in a hair net.

Testing of E, D, D+ Efficiency Tests – PC Members must wear beige or cream jodhpurs, white shirt, Pony Club tie, Pony Club hoodie, gloves, black, navy or brown silk, jodhpur boots and chaps. Long hair must be plaited or in a hair net. No jewellery.

Testing of C, C+ Efficiency Tests – PC Members must wear beige or cream jodhpurs, white shirt, Pony Club tie, jacket, gloves, black, navy or brown silk, jodhpur boots and chaps. Long hair must be plaited or in a hair net. No jewellery.
